A PhD in Philosophy or equivalent, completed prior to the expected start date. A strong foundation in main areas of Contemporary Political Philosophy. A demonstrated ability to perform independent and original research in the area of focus, with an orientation toward internationally recognized publication venues. Teaching experience. A relevant publication record.
